APPROACH

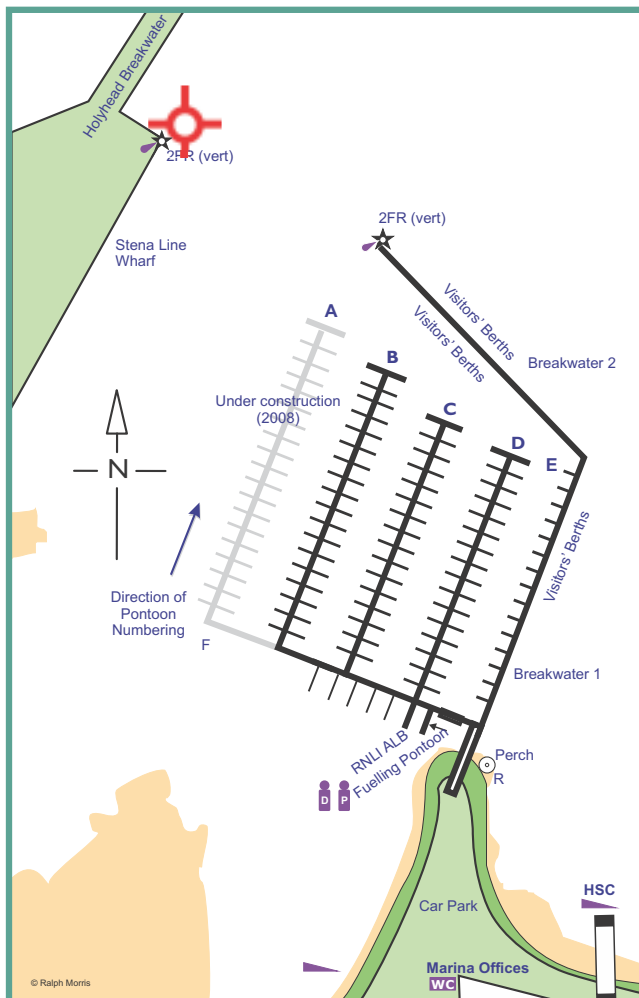
Call "Holyhead Marina" on Channel 37 (M) at Holyhead breakwater head to confirm directions and berthing. On entering Holyhead Harbour keep close to the harbour breakwater and leave the marina Breakwater No.2 to **starboard**. (i.e. do not enter the marina). Breakwater anchors are laid in the outer portion of the fairway and the whole of the area surrounding the pontoons should be considered to be foul ground. Secure to outer side of Breakwater 1 (outer side of Pier E) to report to the marina office. These berths **will not be available in north easterlies**, when visitors should proceed to Pier F, leaving Breakwater 2 and Pier A to port.

SHELTER

Safe within the marina confines, but exposed to significant wave action if on outer side of wave breaks in winds between NE and ESE. In NW storm conditions swell runs down the inner side of Holyhead Breakwater and can cause movement within the marina confines.
